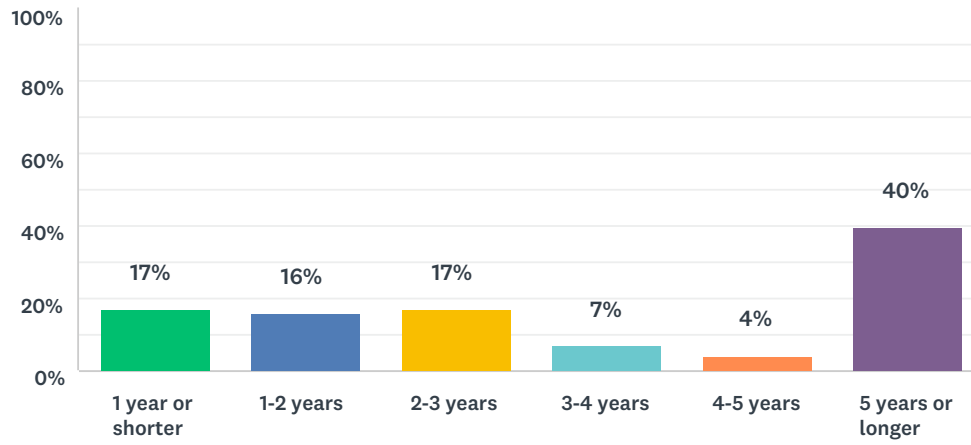


Q1 How long have you been a member of LOTA?

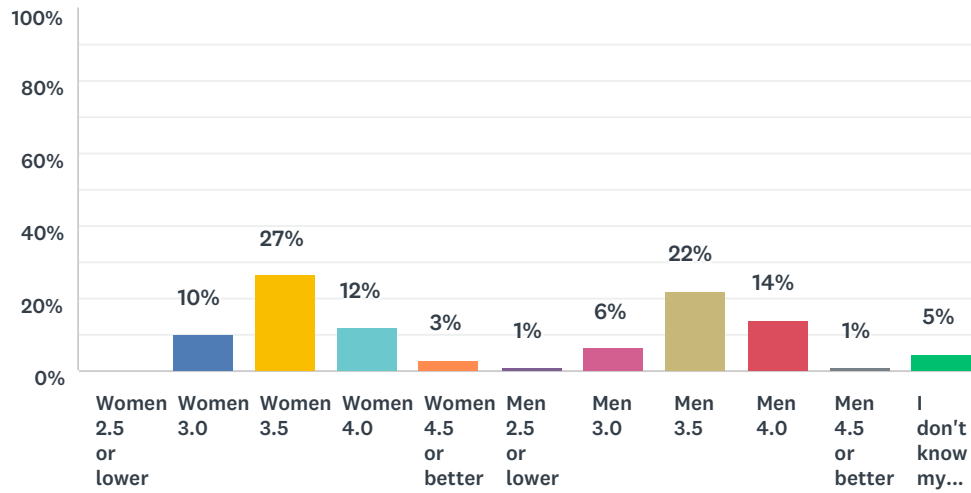

Q2 What is your USTA rating?

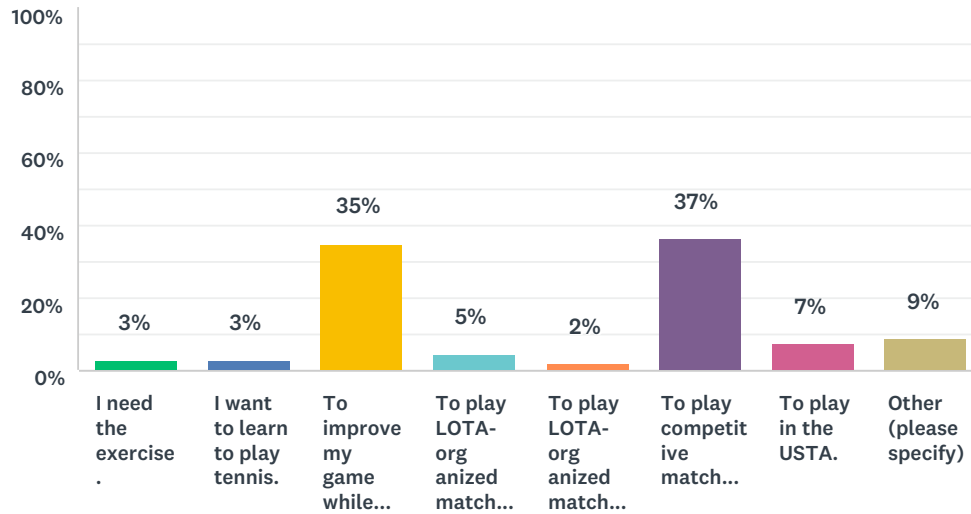

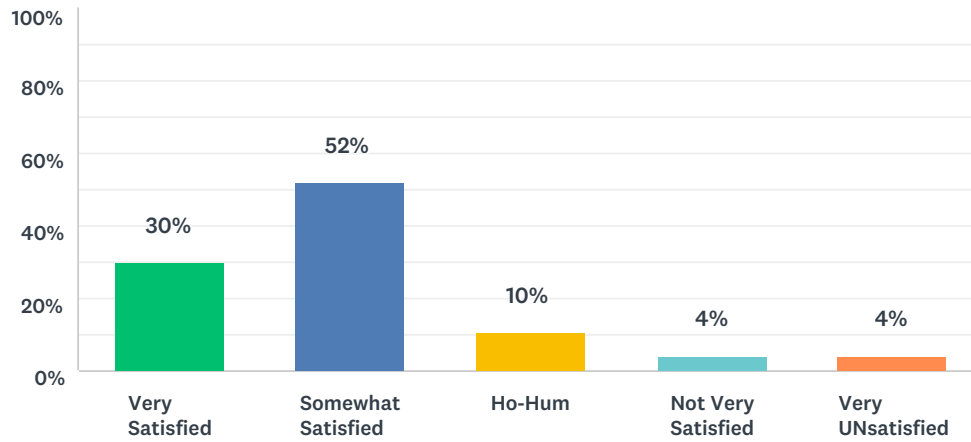

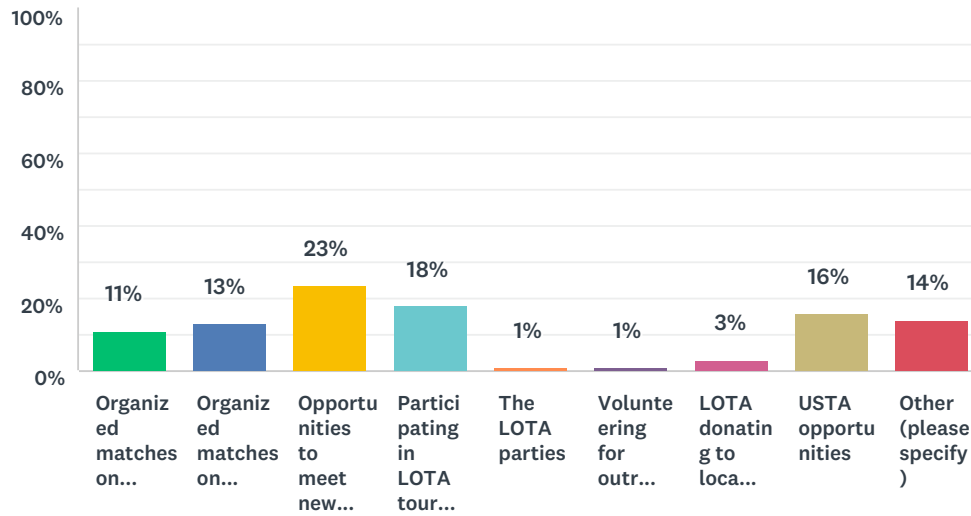

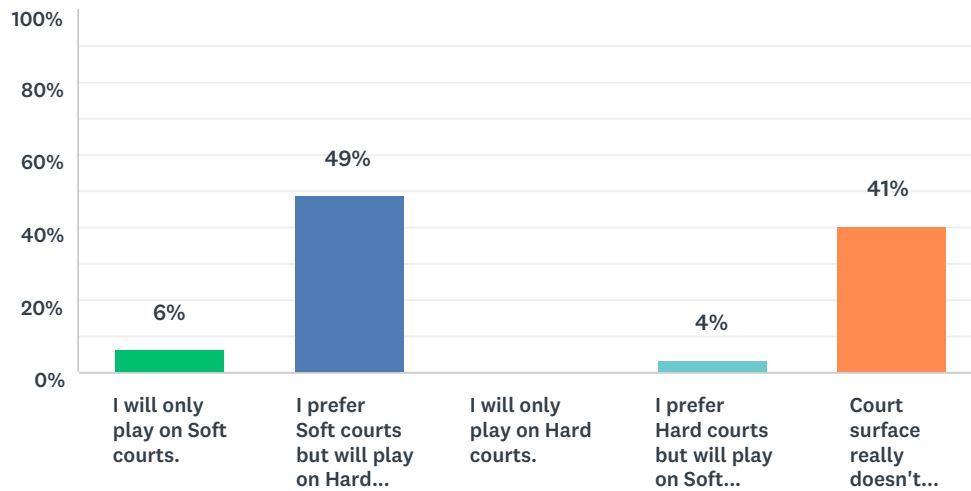

Q6 LOTA schedules leagues and events without regard to playing surface. How does the playing surface affect your participation in LOTA?

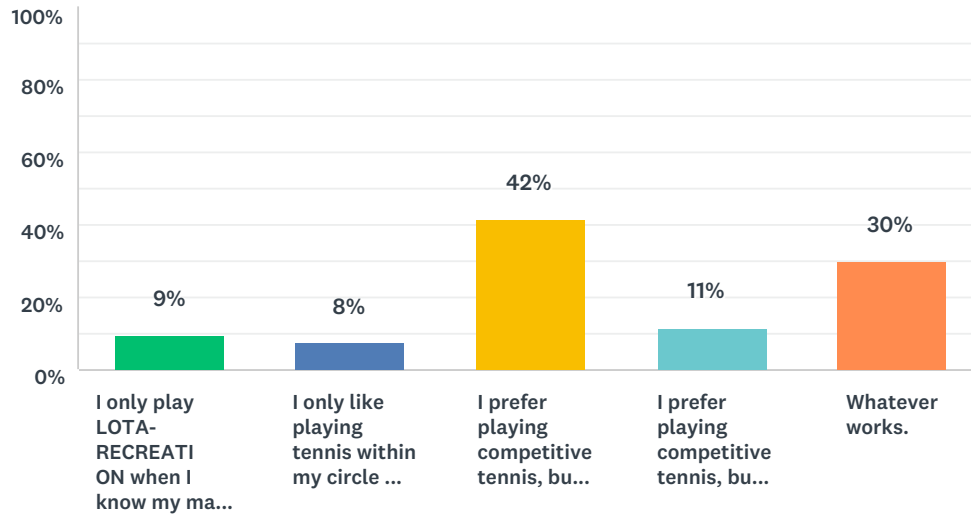

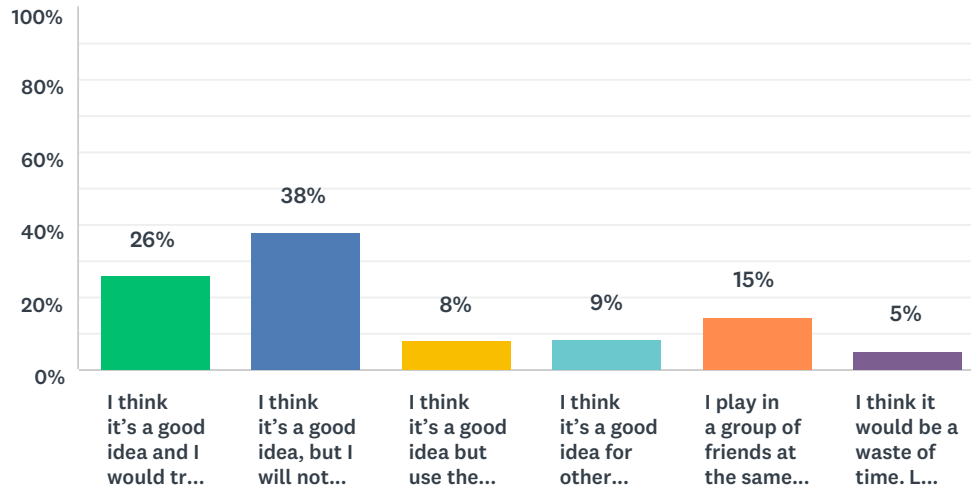

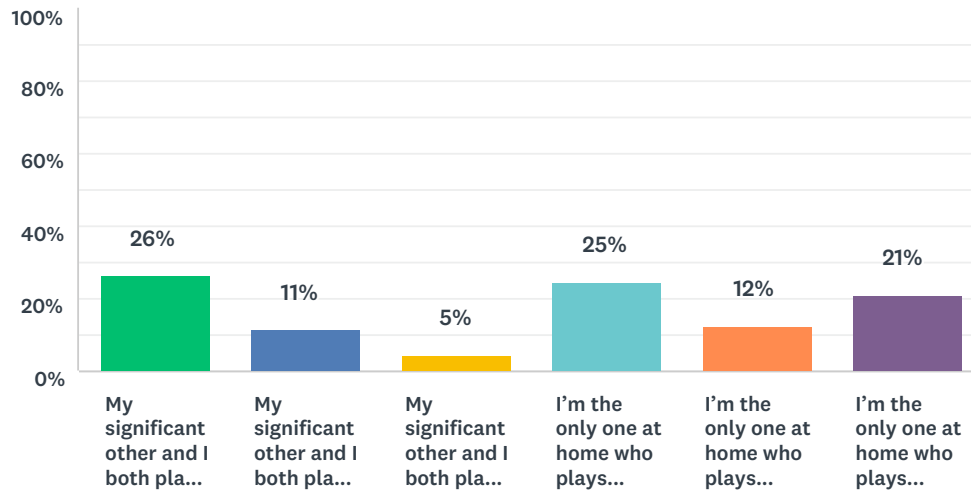

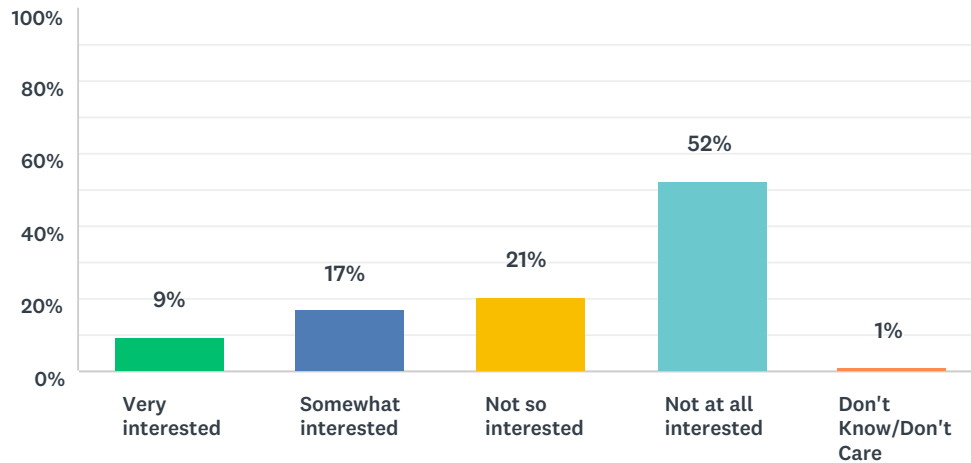

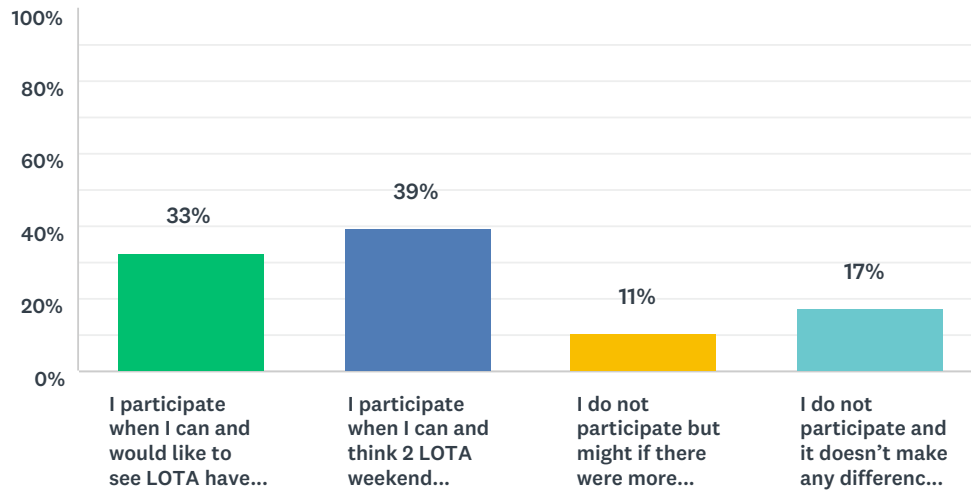

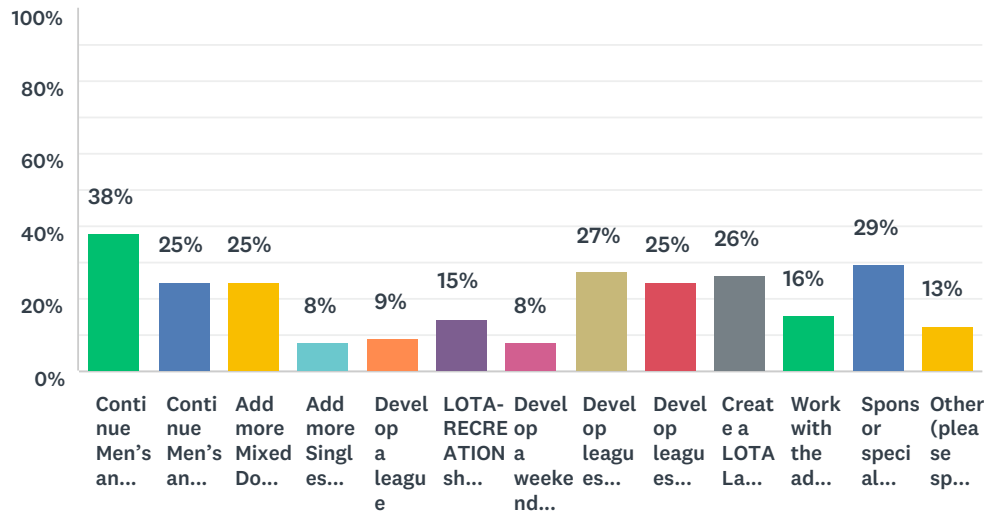

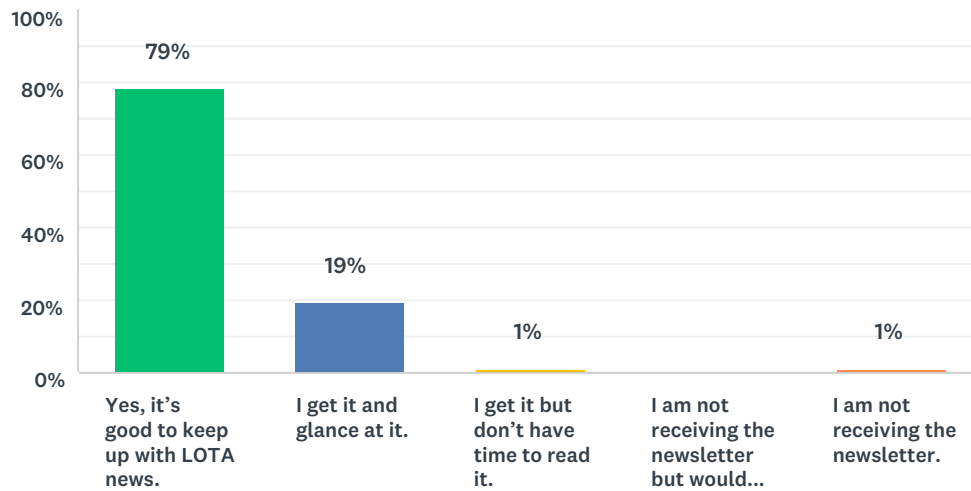

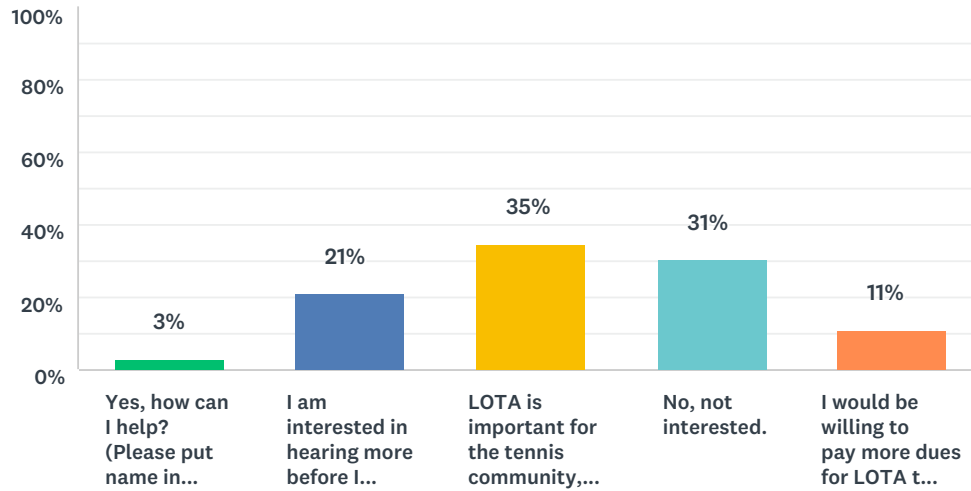
